



This is one of the historical wine cellars in Italy, located in the heart of the old city of Alba, created back in 1881 by Pio Cesare, greatgrandfather of the current owners. These cellars produce and refine wines which are typical of the Langhe: Barolo, Barbaresco, Nebbiolo, Barbera, **Dolcetto and Arneis.**
